On Dec. 25, 1823, in Transcribed Book 10, page 392, Highland County Deed Records, John SANDERS and Ann his wife conveyed two acres to Reuben SHEPHERD, Trustee of the New Market Baptist Church "for the purpose of a meeting house and burying ground forever." On March 26, 1875, in Original Book 64, page 311, Dennis SANDERS and Nancy his wife conveyed 72 poles to the Trustees of New Market Township "in consideration of the Trustees of New Market Township building a good subestantial (sic) board fence around the lot herein after described for the purpose of a burying ground for the public."
